Our UCC State Conference and our Association (Katahdin Association) require churches to pay dues. This year the dues are \$21.00 per member; this amounts to ~3,700 for HSCC to pay annually. Ninety percent of the monies collected are sent to our State Conference for them to continue their work in our State, the remaining ten percent is sent to our Katahdin Association. The monies are used to support the conferences and their work at both the State and Local levels.
